

Online Bible Study FAQ

What do I need to get started?

All you need is your Bible, a notebook or journal, a writing utensil and access to the internet! Additionally, you need 15-30 minutes set aside five days a week, ideally with friends who can go through the study with you!

How does the study work?

There are different levels of participation in this study.

First: Purchase the study book, written by our Central Women Writing team. This book will be your best bet in diving deeper into the study. The book is available in print for \$15, or a downloadable pdf for \$5.

Second: Every Monday morning, you'll receive an email about the study and information for the week.

Third: The Teaching videos will be available to stream on Mondays on RightNow Media. (As soon as videos are available you will receive an invitation to join RightNow Media).

Is there homework?

There are five days of study each week. Four days will include journal prompts and study, the fifth day wraps up with a narrative of the life of person of the Bible. We ask that you would join the conversation on our Facebook group. Joining the discussion will help each of us to process the content we are studying, as well as hear from others on how they are applying what they learn to everyday life!

Do I need to have a certain translation of the bible?

No, we will use NIV for all scripture posted, however any version that you have will work.

How do I connect with women and share what I am learning?

After each study, as you process what you are reading, join the conversation online on the Facebook group. Search <https://www.facebook.com/groups/centralwomenonlinestudy>.

Is there a comment/post policy?

What happens if I don't order a book?

The weekly email on Monday will provide study prompts with reading for the women to participate in, and there will be eight teaching videos available via RightNow Media.

No. Central Women's online Bible studies are free. You have the option to purchase a book to dive deeper. The book is available in print for \$15 or you can purchase a downloadable pdf for \$5.
