 <p><b>SERIES &amp; TITLE</b></p>	LOVE BEYOND...By Believing in Miracles
 <p><b>BIG IDEA</b></p>	It is the Spirit of God in us that makes living for Jesus possible. It's the Spirit of God that transforms lives.
 <p><b>ICE BREAKER</b></p>	What was your favorite cartoon as a kid? Why did you enjoy it so much?
 <p><b>MAIN POINTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Jesus was abandoned by his disciples at his arrest, even though they had promised to stand by him.</li><li>● On the day of Pentecost, Peter was filled with courage by the Holy Spirit to preach the gospel, even though he had deserted Jesus earlier.</li><li>● We are living miracles, proof that God transforms lives!</li><li>● It is the Holy Spirit living in us that makes living for Jesus possible. As believers, the "hydraulic fluid" of the Spirit runs through us and gives us supernatural power.</li><li>● We are called to be witnesses for Jesus, to invite others into relationship with him.</li></ul>
 <p><b>DISCUSS</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Have you ever felt abandoned by friends or family in a difficult time? How did it impact your faith?</li><li>2. Who invited you to church or shared Jesus with you? How did that impact your life?</li><li>3. When have you experienced a time when God empowered you beyond your natural abilities?</li><li>4. Do you believe in miracles? Why or why not? Is there a miracle you've given up on or stopped praying for? What would it take for you to believe in miracles?</li><li>5. Who is that "one" person you can reach out to this week? How can the group support you?</li></ol>
 <p><b>CHALLENGE</b></p>	Place a bulb with your "one" in the LOVE BEYOND sign, take a shirt and be more intentional with that person - pray, love, care for, and take them into your life on a deeper level and invite them to church.
 <p><b>SCRIPTURE</b></p>	Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call."
