



Weekend Recap - Discussion Guide

Selah: A Series on Wisdom, Gratitude and Worship

Week 3: November 26-27

Title: Psalm 78:1-4

Big Idea: The purpose of worship is to uncover the truths that were always within us.

Optional Ice Breaker: Like finding the Dead Sea Scrolls - have you ever happened on something amazing by accident? What was it?

Discuss:

1. What most stuck out to you from the message this weekend?
2. Did you know the story of the Dead Sea Scrolls? What was your reaction?
3. Before hearing the message this weekend when you heard the word "worship" what came to mind? Has that changed now? How?
4. Psalm 78 tells us three things about God: 1) Our God is praiseworthy 2) Our God has all the power 3) Our God has done great wonders. Which of these attributes of God do you most need to remember right now?
5. What does it mean to live a life of worship?

For Students: Psalm 78 talks about setting an example for future generations in what it means to follow Jesus. How do you think you and your generation can start practicing that now?

Challenge: Talk about 1-2 ways that you can worship this week.

Scriptures:

- Psalm 78:1-4 My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old—things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us. We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done.
- Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses..."

Prayer: God, help us to worship with our whole being this week.
