ICE BREAKER	What is one of your favorite meals you've shared with others? What made it meaningful?
MAIN POINTS	 Christianity isn't a solo sport! This passage emphasizes the communal nature of the early church - the words "they," "together," etc The believers were "devoted" to spiritual practices like teaching, fellowship, communion, and prayer. A key theme in this passage is selflessness - selling possessions to give to the needy, worshipping together, etc. Because of the believers' selflessness and devotion, God added daily to their number.
Discuss	 What most stood out to you about this message today? What are some of the benefits of doing our faith together in community rather than individually? What are some challenges? In what ways are you devoted to your faith or spiritual growth? What other areas could use more devotion? How could our church become more "others-focused" and make more of a difference in our community? In what ways do you struggle with selfishness? How could you become more selfless in serving others?
