SERIES & TITLE	<i>Intervention: Discovering How Much God Loves You - Week 3: Shallow Worship</i>
 BIG IDEA	Worship is about Christ, not Christians.
 ICE BREAKER	Pastor Cal shared about being on "autopilot" while driving to work recently. Have you had this experience? When and where?
 DISCUSS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. What most impacted or most stood out to you from church this weekend?2. What would be some signs or indicators for us to recognize that we might be “on auto pilot” instead of truly connecting with God in a tangible way while worshipping Him?3. Are there any practical steps or habits that we can implement into our daily lives in order to ensure that our hearts stay focused on God?4. Pastor Cal shared three dangers when it comes to worship: 1) Turn worship into a ritual 2) Make ourselves the focus and 3) Consume over contribute. Which are you most in danger of?
 FOR STUDENTS	What does worship mean to you? Why do you think so often we regulate it to once a week for an hour on Sunday?
 CHALLENGE	Identify which of the three dangers in worship you most identify or struggle with. What is a step you can take to more authentically and consistently worship God with your words and your actions?
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Isaiah 29:13 The Lord says: "These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is based on merely human rules they have been taught."● Ezekiel 33:31-32 My people come to you, as they usually do, and sit before you to hear your words, but they do not put them into practice. Their mouths speak of love, but their hearts are greedy for unjust gain. Indeed, to them you are nothing more than one who sings love songs with a beautiful voice and plays an instrument well, for they hear your words but do not put them into practice.
 PRAYER	Father God, may I be a person who refuses to just go through the motions but worships You in Spirit and in Truth every day of my life. May my days and weeks be spent glorifying you through my words and my actions. Amen.
