| MAIN POINTS | Our attitudes about prayer are often skeptical or we treat God like a vending machine. The story of Peter's miraculous release from prison shows the power of earnest prayer. The early church prayed persistently for Peter and God responded by sending an angel to free him. Their prayer was specific and believing. We must pray with faith, believing God hears and will respond. Our prayers shouldn't be like a shopping list of demands. The purpose of prayer is to align our hearts with God's will. When the church prays in unity and faith, God works miraculously. Let's pray for the people represented by the lights on our board, expecting God to move. |
