WEEKEND RECAP DISCUSSION GUIDE

CENTRAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH SERIES & TITLE	ALL IN TOGETHER - Trust
-ᢏ͡ᢅ	Only in trusting God can we overcome our fears.
ICE BREAKER	What is the biggest or craziest risk you've ever taken in your life? Did you have complete trust that things would work out, or did you have some underlying fears and doubts?
MAIN POINTS	 God works through four avenues: Plans, Purposes, People, Promises God asks us to trust Him completely, even when it requires sacrificing security and stepping out in faith. For Abraham, it was leaving behind everything familiar to go to an unknown land. Trusting God means surrendering control and overcoming our fears. It's like a child trusting the voice telling them to jump into the pool - they have to overcome fear to follow. Abraham's faith was tested and strengthened through God's big asks over time - possessing Canaan, having a promised child in old age, sacrificing Isaac. Each time, the call was to trust. Biblical faith implies deep reliance, confidence and hope in God even in the face of doubts, anxieties and uncertainty. Complete absence of fear is not required.
Discuss	 What most stood out to you from the message this past weekend? Why is it often so difficult for us to fully trust God, even after seeing evidence of His faithfulness time and again? What fears tend to hold us back from stepping out in faith? Pastor Cal said "Trust doesn't mean there is no fear, concern or anxiety." Have you found this to be true in your own walk of faith? How were you able to press forward despite the lingering doubts? Of the areas Pastor Cal mentioned - trusting God with our salvation, our fears, and our money - which is most challenging for you? What would it look like in your life right now to trust God more fully in that area? As we think about the church's "All In Together" campaign, what would it look like for us to trust God wholeheartedly with our financial resources for kingdom purposes? What are the fears or barriers?
