Welcome

You know it is important to passionately pursue Jesus, but what does it look like to *really* put Jesus at the center of it all? Over this six-week series, you will learn to see Jesus and the kingdom in a whole new light—and learn practices that will help you put your treasure where it belongs.

Series Overview

Week 1: Treasure: Keep Jesus in the Center

Learn a new paradigm for leading people to Christ. Who are you leading on a journey toward Jesus?

Week 6: Inspire: Make Your Life Count

What treasures has Jesus placed in you? How is He calling you to invest them into the kingdom?

Discipleship Insights

- This study will provide your group with opportunities to learn about the Bible, think differently about their lives, and practice new spiritual disciplines. Make a commitment now to *at least try* all of the activities and challenges included within the study. You never know how these different opportunities will support or inspire your Life Group members!
