WHAT IS MY INITIAL REACTION?

The sheep and goats were not separated by how religious they were or how knowledgeable they were. They were separated according to how they treated those who were most vulnerable in their world. When we are following Jesus, we can be certain that he will lead us right to the poor and the broken.

Take a moment to identify the people in your community who are (both literally and spiritually):

Don't allow your group to get away with pat answers. Think hard about your own neighborhood and the communities in which you live. There are people who experience deep poverty of materials, relationship, and spiritual nourishment. There may even be people in your life group who are hungry, thirsty, naked, estranged, or imprisoned.
